

Disaster management, ISA Project

Disaster management is an ongoing practice carried out every month in the school. The school conducts mock drills on a regular basis. Children showcase their readiness and preparedness during special assemblies and through project work. The school's disaster management plan won Rs 25,000/- from National Institute of Disaster management last year. This year it has been expanded extensively to share views with other nations of the world. A comparative study was made with Japan and Indonesia by Class IX and X as a part of the school's ISA activities for 2014-15. First aid training was imparted to the students. Staff and children were taught to operate Fire extinguishers. Charts and pamphlets made by the students were displayed on the notice boards. Students prepared power point presentations on disaster management methods used in different countries along with practices followed in India and screened them before their school mates.
