Sub:- Grant of recognition to the school from Class I-VIII
(Without aid) w.e.f. academic session 1987-88

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject noted above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1987-88 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students of Masjid Moth, (Niti Bagh).
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all the classes of the school as per the present norms of the department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More material shall be purchased.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading-room shall, also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per ratio of 10 books per student may be added and facilities of reading-room may also be provided immediately and more books may be purchased by the start of next session.
6. That adequate sports materials shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately. More sports materials shall be purchased.

7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made as per section 10(1) of Delhi School Edn. Act, 1973 to all the employees.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated 312sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of the class-rooms of proper size in the school.
9. That Middle classes be shifted from the premises of the school on the getting land from the DDA with the permission of the DE.No Branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the department.
11. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
12. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of The DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provisions of Rules 6,7 and 9 be strictly observed.
14. That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
15. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
16. That the violation of any instructions/ orders/conditions/ rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school and class IX shall not be opened without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.

17. That the school society shall apply for the allotment of land and will construct the building as per the specifications of the Directorate of Education, Delhi.
18. That the Management of the school shall provide all the facilities as per rule 50 and all conditions as required under Rule 51 shall be complied with.
19. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education officer every six month.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the Upgradation of the existing Secondary to Senior Secondary level with effect from 1991-92 session with Science, Commerce, Art Stream subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules framed there under as well as the instructions issued from time to time.

2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of secondary classes.
4. That the school shall furnish and equip all the Science Labs as per the norms of the department/CBSE and also purchase more materials by April, 1992 and a list be furnished to DDE(Science) for verification.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may added and more books shall be purchased for senior classes.
6. That more sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students by April 1992 and a list of the same be furnished to E.O. for verification.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made through crossed cheques.
8. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the school and each class-room, science Lab and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the school shall not run unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises, and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately.

- 10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
- 11. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
- 12. That all the facilities prescribed under rule 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
- 13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
- 14. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the School.
- 15. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
- 16. That the provident fund, family pension and group insurance benefits of the employees payable to the employees of recognised private school, shall be made available to the employees of the school, these benefits shall not be less than those of the employees of the corresponding status in schools run by the authority appropriate and recommendation of IV th Pay Commission shall be implemented strictly and reported to the D.O.
- 17. Recognition of Masjid Moth school is hereby stand cancelled and no classes should be run in that premises.
