I want to express my heartfelt gratitude for your unwavering support, and encouragement for the school, and I am glad to share with you some latest attainments and accomplishments i.e. the results of the exceptional hard work of our dear students that our school has attained.

The CBSE All India Class X and XII Board Exam Results 2023-24 were highly commendable with 100% pass percentage. The Class XII QPI is 72.5%. Ajay Pal Singh, the Commerce Stream topper, secured 95.6%, Abhinav Chauhan, the Science Stream topper, secured 93% and Aditya Rathore, the Humanities Stream topper secured 92.6%.

The Class X CBSE Result has been equally remarkable. The QPI secured is 73.5%. Bhavya Sethia is the topper with 93.8% followed by Aryan Ansar with 92.8% and Khush Nayyar with 92.4%.

A number of events have marked the school calendar this year.

The school has been selected as a Pilot Project School for National Credit Framework (NCrF) by CBSE, placing us at the forefront of educational innovation. This distinction allows our students and teachers to benefit from advanced resources, pioneering teaching methods, and enhanced learning experiences, ultimately shaping the future of education and reaffirming our commitment to excellence.

The school proudly hosted the annual exhibition "Navorja 2024", celebrating the International Year of Camelids. The event showcased students' exceptional creativity and innovative displays underscoring their dedication under the teachers' guidance. Your enthusiastic participation and support were instrumental in making this celebration successful.

Furthermore, the renovation of 8 classrooms (Room No. 8 to 15), now enhanced with false ceilings and flooring, has been successfully completed, creating a more conducive learning environment.

School successfully organised Confluence 2024- an array of online inter-school competitions, providing an invaluable platform for children to reveal their talents. Around 450 students from 62 schools across the nation showcased their expertise in a variety of events.

The Mission Life (Lifestyle for Environment) summer camp organized by Harit Dharaa- School's Eco Club, began with an online session where students learned composting from kitchen and waste.

As an extension of our summer camp focusing on Mission Life themes, the Eco Club students emphasized plantation through the initiative 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam'. During Van-Mahotsav, students from Nursery to class VII-maintained classroom corridor gardens for three weeks, earning certificates and thank you notes.

The Rotary Delhi Mankind Club, generously donated a bin for plastic collection at our school. This bin will be used to gather plastic waste, which will then be recycled to help protect the environment. This initiative is crucial for environmental protection. By participating in this initiative, students help minimize the impact of plastic on the environment and promote sustainable practices.

To promote Sanskrit language and the Vedas, various competitions and activities such as *Shloka Uchharan*, Sanskrit songs, role plays are being organized during the *Shravani Parv Saptah* from August 20 to 27.

School has introduced a class-wise assembly initiative, this term, where each class is assigned a thought-provoking theme to explore and express through various art forms.

School celebrated *Shiksha Saptah* from July 22-28, 2024, in honour of the 4th anniversary of NEP 2020. The week was dedicated to promote and celebrate country's rich cultural diversity. Each day of the week focused on a specific theme.

ATL Community Day was celebrated in the school with a vibrant gathering of students from various schools. Students were engaged in creative activities and there were also introduced to smart technologies guided by experts like Mr. Gauri Dutt Sharma. These experiences have ignited creativity and critical thinking, preparing our students for a tech-driven future.

Youth Ideathon Workshop was held in the school focusing on generating innovative ideas and solving problems.

Avni Bhatia (XII) has been elected as the ZIR (Zonal Interact Representative) by the Rotary Club of Delhi 3011. This prestigious appointment empowers her to lead a team of four schools in executing various social service initiatives during the academic year 2024-25. This achievement is a proud milestone for our school's Interact Club and a notable accomplishment for the Rotary Club of Mankind.

Divyam Agrawal (XII) has successfully cleared Round 1 of the GYS Avishkar Awards 2024 and is now qualified for Round 2, which includes Online demonstration of his project based on Caliper – X (prosthetic leg).

Four innovative ideas from our school have been selected in the Youth Ideathon- a national competition by Think startup, and Management Entrepreneurship Professional Skills Council (MEPSC) in association with CBSE. The achievement highlights our students' creativity and their ability to turn ideas into real solutions.

To inculcate the leadership qualities in the students, the school hosted an **Investiture Ceremony**, where a rigorous selection process, including interviews and brainstorming sessions, led to the formation of the Student Council. The elected leaders were conferred with badges and sashes. The Head Boy, **Rabant Roy**, and the Head Girl, **Avni Bhatia** along with their elected members pledged to uphold the school's values and motto in high esteem, marking the beginning of their journey as student leaders.

Our students showed their prowess in 'Confluence 2024'- an array of online inter-school competitions held in the school, wherein Kimaya Mishra (I) secured the second position in the 'Make Fruits Your Friend' competition, Hardik Sharma (II) achieved the third position in the event 'Matti Srijan', and Naman Jain (VIII) and Ravin Harsh (VIII) clinched the second position in 'Gamification'.

Our students continue to shine beyond the school premises as well. Sarthak Singh (IX) and Mohammad Aayaan (IX) have brought immense pride to the institution by securing the first position in 'Digital Dreamscapes'- an inter-school competition organized at DAV PS, Sector 49, Gurugram.

At the inter-school 'Kriti Event' held at DAV Ashok Vihar, under the sub-theme 'We Care Mother Earth (Craft the Imagination)', Hardik Singh Rawat (V) and Mihir Singh Rawat (V) showcased their creativity and environmental consciousness by winning the second prize in the 'Wealth Out of Waste' competition.

Our students excelled in the 2nd Level of the National Science Olympiad, with Navya Gupta (IV), Dhruv Chandna (V), Ipsita Mohanty (VI), and Zainab Nazim (VII) winning merit certificates. In the International Mathematics Olympiad, Akshita Dutta (VI), Satyam Singh (VIII), Ishan Khosla (IX), and Maulik Jain (X) also received merit certificates.

EXAMINATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The examination for classes IV to XII will commence as per date sheet attached. Kindly ensure your ward works hard to secure the required grades.

2. Students will report as usual in the morning at 7:50 am during examination.

- 3. School buses for all classes will ply back at 12:15 pm from 9th September till 25th September 2024.
- 4. Examination of class IV will be over by 11 am and after the exam revision of the next scheduled exam will be taken by the respective teacher.
- 5. Preparatory holidays for classes will be as follows: Classes (VI, VIII, X, XI and XII) 5th September to 8th September 2024 Classes (IV, V, VII and IX) 7th September to 9th September 2024.
- 6. Exams of A.I. (Classes IX and X), A.I. / Music/ Painting (Class XI), Music (Class XII) will be conducted on 2nd September 2024 within school hours.
- 7. G.K. exam of classes IV to VIII will be conducted on 2nd September 2024.
- 8. Naitik Shiksha exam of Class VIII will be conducted on 4th September 2024.
- 9. Assessment of Physical education, ICT and Art for classes 4 to 12 (wherever applicable) will be done during school hours.
- 10. Use of unfair means or cheating in the examination will be strictly dealt with.
- 12. Regular classes will resume from 26th September 2024.
- 13. P.T.M. will be held on 05.10.2024 to discuss the performance of your ward in the Examination.
