INTRODUCTION:

APRIL-MAY

THEME MYSELF

LIFE SKILLS AND ACTIVITIES

- Palm printing, foot printing, and thumb printing.
- Draw/stick picture of self in a photo frame.
- Draw and stick family picture. Write the names, date of birth, occupation etc. of all your family members.

JULY

THEME CLEANLINESS

LIFE SKILLS AND ACTIVITIES

- Practical skills related to hygiene of body and surroundings (polishing shoes, tying shoe laces, brushing teeth twice a day, cutting nails, combing hair, organizing school bags and wardrobe, use of dustbin, washing hands before and after eating, using handkerchief).
- Enactment or dramatization of different advertisements related to cleanliness.
- Skills related to personal cleanliness like washing hands, brushing teeth, wiping nose etc.
- Good touch & Bad touch

AUGUST

THEME FOOD

LIFE SKILLS AND ACTIVITIES

- Practical skills related to health and fitness (eat healthy food, avoid junk food, table manners, use of napkin or table mats, use of spoon and fork, eat food without spilling, eat food with mouth closed).
- Salad making, fruit chat, bhelpoori, sandwich making, lemonade etc.
- Simple exercises like stretching of arms and legs and neck exercises.

SEPTEMBER

THEME CLOTHING

LIFE SKILLS AND ACTIVITIES

- Wearing neat clothes, and uniform, folding clothes, buttoning and unbuttoning of shirts, polishing shoes, tying shoe laces, organizing wardrobe independently.

OCTOBER

LIFE SKILLS AND ACTIVITIES
